I've reviewed your 2014 exempt distribution report dated January 13, 2014.

Please revise and resubmit your report to indicate that the byproduct material is transferred for use under 10 CFR 30.14 or equivalent regulations of an Agreement State. In your report, you indicated the concentration of radioactive material at introduction and at transfer; however, you did not identify the quantity of radionuclide introduced into each product or material. In revising your report, please identify the type and quantity of radionuclide introduced into each product or material.
