Aim Update



- Commission approval in June 2015
- General Direction
 - Seek to achieve the highest standards of performance
 - Enhance our ability to adjust to the changing environment by being more agile
 - Identify opportunities to apply more broadly risk insights to enhance our decision-making beyond traditional technical issues
 - Apply decision-making that uses a graded approach when determining priorities and the level of resources

Rebaselining



- Key strategy
- What is the new baseline or “normal”?
- Ensure that NRC performs work needed to fulfill mission and performs efficiently
 - Assess priorities of work (common prioritization)
 - Identify and achieve efficiencies of retained work
- Complete by April 2016 (prepare FY2017)
