In regards to receiving a letter from the Nuclear Regulatory Commission dated August 31, 2015,  
Reference # GL-702300

This letter was addressed to OFS Plant 1 (previously Executive Furniture) and according to this letter  
there is a general license in regards to owning de-ionizing guns that use Polonium 210.

All of our facilities have only ever used electrical (aka Corona) ionization guns.

I spoke with Hector Rodrigues-Luccioni a couple of times in regards to this letter. First he said it was  
equipment purchased with in the last 6 months and gave me serial #s A2ABP267 and A2ABP268.


In working with Plant 1, there were no guns that either used Polonium nor had these serial numbers. So  
I called Mr. Hector Rodrigues-Luccioni back to let him know this. Then Mr. Hector Rodrigues-Luccioni in  
looking at his records changed his story and said that they were purchased back in 2001 and gave me  
the following Serial numbers, A2AP457 and A2AP468. Again, after rechecking all of our equipment, all  
of our electrical ionization did not match. I also called our accounts payable office to see if there was  
any purchase records from the company we supposedly bought from, AEA Technology in Arlington  
Heights, Illinois. Although the name had been set up in the accounts payable system, it showed no  
records and no payment of any type.

I also called AEA Technology (1-800-815-1383) and they too showed no records.

We have exhausted all efforts and show no records of ever having an Alpha ionization air gun using  
polonium 210, a nuclear source.
