To Whom It May Concern,

On November 5th, 2015, Strata Energy, Inc. (Strata) submitted a letter to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) regarding Strata's Source Material License SUA-1601 License Condition (LC) 12.7. The letter addressed two main deficiencies in a previous submittal regarding LC 12.7. Specifically, the NRC requested further clarifications regarding how the results of various commitments would be submitted to the NRC, and the duration that the commitments would be upheld. Strata provided clarification on these issues with the November 5th, 2015 letter. On November 10th, 2015, the NRC had a Project Manager to Project Manager (PM to PM) phone call requesting clarification on one of the issues addressed in the November 5th letter, namely the duration that the commitments would be upheld.

Strata is hereby providing additional clarification in regards to the statement made in the November 5th letter, "until adequate data is collected". Strata commits to conducting all commitments made in regards to LC 12.7 at the frequency specified in previous submittals made to the NRC. If at a later date Strata determines that certain sampling requirements of the commitments can be discontinued or reduced, Strata will follow the appropriate change process to determine if those aspects of the commitments can be discontinued or reduced. Strata understands the importance and regulatory basis for effluent monitoring and ensuring dose to members of the public is below applicable limits, and will proceed accordingly.
