Thank you for your letter dated October 27, 2015, requesting that the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) facilitate the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) liaison deployment in the NRC Headquarters Operations Center (HOC) during heightened threat or emergency response situations when it is determined that law enforcement assistance may be needed. This letter is to confirm that the NRC agrees with the FBI proposal to embed two individuals in the HOC during these situations. Additionally, this letter confirms that the NRC will provide the logistical, training and exercise support identified in Items 1-6 of your October 27, 2015, letter.
