SUBJECT: COMMUNICATION PLAN FOR GENERIC ISSUE 199,

The staff of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) has developed the enclosed communication plan for Generic Issue (GI) 199, "Implications of Updated Probabilistic Seismic Hazard Estimates in Central and Eastern United States on Existing Plants."
