SUBJECT: NRC PETITION FOR RULEMAKING DOCKETING REVIEW, PRM-2-15 [NRC-2015-0264]

Dear Mr. Skov:

This letter is in reference to the petition for rulemaking (PRM), dated October 22, 2015, that you filed with the U.S Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC).¹ You request that the NRC amend Part 2 of Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR), "Agency rules of practice and procedure," to require that NRC establish procedures for 1) responding to adverse court decisions, and 2) procedures for annually reporting to the public each instance where the NRC does not receive sufficient funds reasonably necessary to implement in good faith its statutory mandates. The NRC docketed your petition pursuant to 10 CFR 2.803, "Petition for rulemaking-NRC action," on November 10, 2015, and assigned it Docket No. PRM-2-15 and Docket ID NRC-2015-0264. Please reference this docket number and ID on any correspondence you may have concerning your petition.
