**ORDER CONVERTING CASE TO A CHAPTER 7 LIQUIDATION CASE;
SETTING MEETING OF CREDITORS;
SETTING DEADLINE FOR CREDITORS TO FILE CLAIMS;
DIRECTING DEBTOR TO FILE REQUIRED PLEADINGS;
GIVING NOTICE OF APPOINTMENT OF CHAPTER 7 TRUSTEE; DIRECTING
OFFICERS TO PRESERVE ASSETS AND TURNOVER TO TRUSTEE**

On this day, the United States Trustee, by Counsel, David Bissett, submitted this order pursuant to an order entered on June 22, 2015, resolving the United States Trustee's Motion to Convert Case to Chapter 7. The terms of that order allowed the Debtor time to wind up business operations and the case would convert to Chapter 7 effective on August 10, 2015. Accordingly, it is

ORDERED AND NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that this Chapter 11 case is converted to a case under Chapter 7 of the Bankruptcy Code effective on August 10, 2015. It is further

ORDERED AND NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the debtor, by a responsible officer or member who can answer questions of the trustee and creditors, shall appear for a Meeting of Creditors on October 8, 2015 at 11:30 a.m. in the Jury Assembly Room, Room G07, Robert C. Byrd U.S. Courthouse, 110 North Heber Street, Beckley, West Virginia. It is further

ORDERED AND NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that any creditor who desires to share in any distribution must file a proof of claim within ninety (90) days after the date set above for the Meeting of Creditors. If a creditor has previously filed a proof of claim in the Chapter 11 reorganization case, such creditor is not required to file again unless the status of the claim has changed. It is further

ORDERED that, within fourteen (14) days after the entry of this Order, the Debtor shall file the schedules and statements required by Bankruptcy Rule 1007(b)(1) and shall also file Conversion Schedules that include:

- a. A Schedule of Unpaid Debts that were incurred after the commencement of the Chapter 11 case but before conversion;
- b. Amended Schedules A and B showing assets owned as of the date the case is converted;

c. Amended Schedule G showing any leases or executory contracts as of the date the case is converted;

d. An amended mailing matrix that contains the names and addresses of all creditors listed in the Schedule of Unpaid Debts; and

e. Certification by counsel for the Debtor that a copy of this Order was served upon all creditors listed in the Schedule of Unpaid Debts.

ORDERED that, within thirty (30) days after the entry of this Order the debtor shall file a final report and account of the administration of the estate, pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 1019(5), of the administration of the estate, for the month prior to conversion, which follows the format of the monthly operating report.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the United States Trustee has designated Robert L. Johns, 216 Brooks Street, Suite 301, Charleston, West Virginia, 25301; (304) 720-2300 to serve as Chapter 7 Trustee in this case. It is further

ORDERED that the debtor's officers or members shall cooperate with the trustee as required by 11 U.S.C. §521 in the orderly transfer of assets and business records to the trustee, and shall assist the trustee in all matters as required by law. The debtor shall promptly turnover to the Chapter 7 trustee all records and property of the estate in the possession or control of the debtor, as required by Bankruptcy Rule 1019(4). It is further

ORDERED that the debtor's officers or members shall preserve all the assets, funds, and business records of the debtor, until those items are transferred to the trustee or abandoned.
