Writing Rules on Lessons Learned From Fukushima

My comments...

It is patently absurd, and extremely dangerous, to allow US nuclear plants to "voluntarily" implement the new SAMGs changes. One of the lessons learned from Fukushima is that plant owners lie and obfuscate about details in a severe accident. NRC is supposed to be protecting the public and the only responsible action to take here is to REQUIRE plant management to follow the Severe Accident Management Guidelines.

Frankly, the NRC even suggesting that this could be voluntary shows that the public is not being protected. I thought the NRC, when it replaced the AEC, was supposed to act to protect the public interest primarily. It is certainly not doing that with these guidelines and is clearly not doing any better than the terrible record of the AEC.

Please REQUIRE that plant management implement the SAMGs guidelines. Anything less violates the NRC mission.
