SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF THE AUGUST 4, 2015, PUBLIC TELECONFERENCE
MEETING TO DISCUSS OPEN ITEMS AND OUTSTANDING ISSUES
RELATED TO THE NUCLEAR INNOVATION NORTH AMERICA, LLC.,
SOUTH TEXAS PROJECT, UNITS 3 AND 4, COMBINED LICENSE
APPLICATION

On August 4, 2015, a Category 1 public teleconference was held between the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) and representatives of Nuclear Innovation North America, LLC. (NINA). The meeting notice was issued on July 21, 2015, and was documented in the Agencywide Documents Access and Management System under accession number ML15202A117. The purpose of this meeting was for the NRC staff and NINA to discuss, ask questions, or note concerns regarding relevant licensing and technical issues of the South Texas Project (STP), Units 3 and 4, combined license application. A list of attendees is provided as an enclosure.

The following topics were discussed, followed by its outcome:

Indemnity

The discussion was on how and when to demonstrate payment of deferred premium and information needed for the indemnity agreement to include all four STP units. With respect to secondary insurance, the staff informed NINA that a license condition for consideration to ensure payment of the deferred premium will be developed. This information will be available for the next meeting. The staff informed the missing information needed to complete the indemnity agreement amendment. This amendment is not required for the STP, Units 3 and 4, licensing finding.

Decommissioning Funding

With the request for additional information responses, the staff informed NINA that no additional information is needed.

10 CFR 52.103(g) Finding and Protected Area

The staff informed NINA that Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) Part 52.103(g) signifies the completion of all inspections, tests, analysis and acceptance criterion (ITAACs), including those that are required to establish the protected area (PA). Therefore, prior to 10 CFR 52.103(g), although portions of the PA are constructed at various times, and associated ITAACs are also completed, as a system, the PA is not established until after 10 CFR 52.103(g). This interpretation may affect construction schedule such as fuel load, the staff does not believe it has any schedule impact on the licensing decisions. NINA was requested to review its application and advise if there is an agreement.
