SUBJECT: TERMINATION OF NRC RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS LICENSE NO. 25-35079-01

By letter dated August 21, 2015, you informed the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) that you wished to terminate your NRC radioactive materials license. The NRC Form 314 dated August 21, 2015, stated that no radioactive material had ever been procured or processed by the licensee under this license.

A review of the historical file supported that no radioactive material had ever been procured or processed by the licensee under this license. Based on the documentation submitted and a review of your historical file, the staff concluded that 1179 Stillwater Road, Kalispell, Montana, is suitable for unrestricted use in accordance with 10 CFR 20.1402, "Radiological Criteria for Unrestricted Use." Based on these conclusions, no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material is required.

Please find enclosed Amendment No. 01 to License No. 25-35079-01 authorizing your license termination. An environmental assessment for this action is not required since this action is categorically excluded under 10 CFR 51.22(c)(20)(ii).
