Entergy submitted Relief Request 18 (RR-18) [Reference] in the Fourth Ten-Year Inservice Inspection Interval pursuant to 10 CFR 50.55a(z)(1). The request was made to implement alternative examination requirements based on American Society of Mechanical Engineers (ASME) Code Case N-702 and Boiling Water Reactor Vessel and Internals Project BWRVIP-241.

Subsequent to this letter, issues with some data provided in the relief request have been identified. This has been discussed with the NRC Senior Project Manager. Based on these discussions with the NRC staff, Entergy is withdrawing Relief Request 18.
