AMENDMENT TO INDEMNITY AGREEMENT NO. B-54
AMENDMENT NO. 8

Effective _____, 2015, Indemnity Agreement No. B-54, between Florida Power Corporation, City of Alachua, City of Bushnell, City of Gainesville, City of Kissimmee, City of Leesburg, City of New Smyrna Beach and Utilities Commission, City of Ocala, Orlando Utilities Commission and City of Orlando, Sebring Utilities Commission, Seminole Electric Cooperative, Inc., City of Tallahassee, and the United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission, dated June 20, 1973, as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:

The name "Florida Power Corporation" is deleted wherever it appears in the agreement and substituted in lieu thereof by the name:

"Duke Energy Florida, Inc."

Except for Seminole Electric Cooperative, Inc., all of the following signatories are to be deleted from the agreement: City of Alachua; City of Bushnell; City of Gainesville; City of Kissimmee; City of Leesburg; City of New Smyrna Beach and Utilities Commission; City of Ocala; Orlando Utilities Commission and City of Orlando; Sebring Utilities Commission; and City of Tallahassee.

Item 1 of the Attachment to the indemnity agreement is modified by deleting the name "Florida Power Corporation," wherever it appears in the agreement and substituted in lieu thereof by the name:

Item 1 – Licensee Duke Energy Florida, Inc.


