I'm commenting on the proposed rulemaking "Variable Annual Fee Structure for Small Modular Reactors" (RIN 3150-A154) and Docket ID NRC-2008-0664.

I would like to offer my strong support of this proposed rule change. It is a smart and fair way to appropriately assign regulatory costs to companies designing something other than large LWRs.

While I would prefer having this new rule apply to all types of new nuclear fission reactor designs (e.g. sodium cooled, molten salt, etc.) and not just light-water versions (by striking the phrase "light-water" from the first sentence in the summary), this is definitely a step in the right direction.
