Dear Dr. Marcus,

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) published a document in the Federal Register on June 23, 2015, informing the public that we docketed your petition for rulemaking (PRM), PRM-20-28, dated February 9, 2015 (Accession No. [ML15051A503](#) in the NRC's Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS)). The NRC received two additional petitions on the same topic (PRM-20-29 and PRM-20-30); all three petitions were docketed using the same Docket ID (NRC-2015-0057). The NRC will examine the issues raised in your petition together with those raised in the other petitions and will determine whether these issues should be considered in the NRC's rulemaking process. This document also requested public comments on your PRM and the public comment period closed on September 8, 2015. On August 21, 2015, the NRC published a document extending the comment period until November 19, 2015, to allow more time for members of the public to develop and submit their comments.

As of November 23, 2015, the NRC has received 561 individual public comments and 2,511 form letter comments on your PRM. Individual public comment submissions received on your PRM will be available on the Federal rulemaking Web site, <http://www.regulations.gov>, by searching on Docket ID NRC-2015-0057. For your convenience, a list of the ADAMS accession numbers for all of the form letter comments that have been received is available in ADAMS under [ML15327A061](#).
