The purpose of this email is to acknowledge receipt of your letter and its attachments dated October 26, 2015, in response to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC) letter dated October 1, 2015 transmitting a Notice of Violation.

The NRC has reviewed the corrective actions identified in your letter, which so far appear to be adequate. Per our discussion earlier today, we understand that because of unforeseen difficulties in shipping leak tests to your service provider for analysis, you have not yet been able to complete all corrective actions as described in our October 1, 2015 letter. However, we also understand that you are currently in the process of completing these actions, and that you expect to receive the analysis of the remaining leak tests within two to three weeks. We request that you please provide us a copy via email of the leak test results when you receive them as a supplement to your original reply.
