**Nuclear Energy Standards Coordination Collaborative Meeting**

On October 13, 2015, staff from the Office of Nuclear Regulatory Research, the Office of New Reactors, and the Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation participated in a meeting of the Nuclear Energy Standards Coordination Collaborative (NESCC). This panel meets 2 – 3 times per year to discuss ways to accelerate the development and implementation of nuclear energy-related codes and standards. The NESCC is sponsored and led by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) and the Department of Energy, with coordination assistance from the American National Standards Institute. Other participants included several standards developing organizations, as well as industry and government stakeholders. The group discussed accomplishments of the past six years and status of planned standards development. Following this meeting, the format will transition to an annual NRC-hosted workshop.
