The following additional information is needed to complete the review of your request to terminate Chicago Testing Laboratory d/b/a Indianapolis Testing Laboratory's, NRC License 13-32754-01.

1. Please provide a history of all the radionuclides used/stored at your facility at 1432 Sadlier Circle East Drive, Indianapolis, Indiana. For example, we used millicurie amounts of cesium-137 and americium-241/beryllium in sealed source form in Troxler Model 3440 moisture/density gauges.
2. Please specify the date when and which moisture/density gauges were transferred to GME Testing and the date when and which moisture/density gauges were transferred to Chicago Testing Laboratory.
3. Please submit leak test results that were current when the moisture/density gauges were transferred to GME Testing and Chicago Testing Laboratory.
4. Please submit a copy of the Chicago Testing Laboratory Illinois license IL02065-01.
5. Please submit copies of the acknowledgement letter/document(s) that shows when the moisture/density gauges were received and which moisture/density gauges were received by GME Testing and when and which moisture/density gauges were received by Chicago Testing Laboratory.
