Dear Mr. Driscoll:

In a letter dated September 1, 2015 and by NRC Form 314, "Certificate of Disposition of Materials" dated August 31, 2015, you contacted the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) and indicated that the licensee, University of Michigan, wished to terminate its NRC radioactive material license no. 21-00215-06. The NRC staff has reviewed the final status of the program and has concluded that all licensable radioactive material has been removed from the facility and residual radioactive material attributable to licensed activities does not exceed current NRC criteria.

Based on these conclusions no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material is required. Your facility is suitable for release for unrestricted use and NRC license number 21-00215-06 is hereby terminated.
