LICENSEE:

The inspection was an examination of the activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) rules and regulations and the conditions of your license. The inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector. The inspection findings are as follows:

3. The violations, specifically described to you by the inspector as non-cited violations, are not being cited because they were self-identified, non-repetitive, and corrective action was or is being taken, and the remaining criteria in the NRC Enforcement Policy to exercise discretion were satisfied.

Non-Cited Violation was discussed involving the following requirements and Corrective Actions:

→ License Condition 19 specifies that the licensee is authorized to transport licensed material in accordance w/ 10 CFR 71. 10 CFR 71.5(a) requires, in part, that the licensee comply w/ applicable requirements of 49 CFR Parts 107, 171-180. 49 CFR 172.704(c)(2) requires that a hazmat employee must receive the training required by 49 CFR Subpart H at least once every three years. Contrary to the above, between May 19, 2015 - October 16, 2015, a licensee hazmat employee transported DOT Class 7 material and did not have hazmat training in accordance w/ 49 CFR 172 Subpart H. AS

X 4. During this inspection certain of your activities, as described below and/or attached, were in violation of NRC requirements and are being cited. This form is a NOTICE OF VIOLATION, which may be subject to posting in accordance with 10 CFR 19.11.

Corrective action, the licensee committed to complete the required training by October 23, 2015. This is a SLIV violation. (Section 6.8.2)
