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Subject: Comments Concerning Draft NUREG-1530, Revision 1, "Reassessment of NRC's Dollar Per Person-Rem Conversion Factor Policy," (80FR53585, dated September 4, 2015, Docket ID NRC-2015-0063)

This letter is being submitted in response to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) request for comments concerning draft NUREG-1530, Revision 1, "Reassessment of NRC's Dollar Per Person-Rem Conversion Factor Policy," published in the *Federal Register* on September 4, 2015 (i.e., 80FR53585).

This proposed revision to NUREG-1530 would revise the dollar per person-rem conversion factor. The NRC uses the dollar per person-rem conversion factor in cost-benefit analyses to determine the monetary valuation of the consequences associated with radiological exposure and establishes this factor by multiplying a Value of a Statistical Life (VSL) coefficient by a nominal risk coefficient.

Exelon Generation Company, LLC (Exelon) appreciates the opportunity to comment on this draft NUREG revision. Exelon fully supports the comments submitted by the Nuclear Energy Institute (NEI) on behalf of the industry regarding the subject draft NUREG.
