As a Lead Technologist of a military hospital, I was responsible for "counseling" the patient in layman terms of what to do and not to do after being released from the hospital after treatment of 100-200mCi of 131 iodine. The patient was instructed to wash their clothes twice and separately from the others in the house, do not share food from the same eating utensils, wash dishes and utensils twice, when using the bathroom-flush twice, married couples sleep in separated beds, and keep distance of at least 6 feet from family members and pregnant women. Time frame for this is 3-4 days.

Any amount of 131 Iodine over 30 mCi would be hospitalized in an isolated room until a reading of <7mR/hr is achieved
