**Well DM-004A:** Upper Control Limits (UCL) for alkalinity and chloride have been exceeded: Alkalinity @ 194 mg/L CaCO3 (UCL = 188) and Chloride @ 19 mg/L (UCL = 18). Pursuant to Permit 633, Operations Plan, Section 12.3.1, a written notice to the WDEQ-LQD will be provided within 5 days (on or before 12/9/15). Well DM-004A will be sampled every seven days for chloride, alkalinity, conductivity, and uranium until the excursion is mitigated.
