Dear Ms. Groves:

This email refers to your application dated September 3, 2015, which requested a license amendment to add various models of lamps manufactured by UNILAM Co., Ltd. to your license.

As I explained in the voice mail that I left for your today, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) sent you a letter dated September 28, 2015, which requested that you provide additional information concerning your application within 30 calendar days of the date of the letter (i.e., by October 28, 2015).

To date, it appears that we have not received the requested information. If we do not received the requested information by Thursday, December 10, 2015, we may void your application. If you have already submitted the requested information, please inform us.

Voidance of your license amendment request would be taken without prejudice to the resubmission of your request; therefore, your application could be re-opened once the NRC receives a complete response to our request for additional information.
