Subject: Remaining Se capsules from cycle 462

Kevin and John,

The hot cell facility has completed the decon of the remaining capsules from cycle 462. After several decon steps, all the remaining capsules have meet the smear limits and a single leaking capsule has not been identified. We will package these for shipment next week if all goes as planned. This still remains a mystery. Was the contamination due to material in the weld area, or did a crack open under higher temperature releasing material and then close back upon cooling, or does the deconning not penetrate the capsule and continue leaching material. Feedback and a closer examination of the capsules upon receipt at your facilities would be appreciated.
