NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Dear Mr. Frick:

On November 24, 2015, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) cited The Cancer Center of Hawaii, LLC, for failure to perform required monitoring of packages containing radioactive material. The Notice of Violation, enclosed with NRC Inspection Report 030-36775/2015-001 (ML15322A395), required you to respond in writing within 30 days. You responded by letter received on December 22, 2015 (ML15362A623).

After reviewing the information provided in the response to the Notice of Violation, we have concluded that the completed and proposed corrective actions appear to adequately address the regulatory noncompliance described in the Notice of Violation. We will review the implementation of these corrective actions during a future inspection to determine whether full compliance has been restored and whether compliance will be maintained.
