**SUBJECT: NRC ROUTINE INSPECTION REPORT NO. 03002286/2015001(DNMS) AND
NOTICE OF VIOLATION – SAINT LUKE'S HOSPITAL OF KANSAS CITY**

Dear Mr. Schemenauer:

On December 1 through 4, 2015, an inspector from the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) conducted a routine inspection at your facilities in Kansas City and Chillicothe, Missouri. The purpose of the inspection was to review activities performed under your NRC license to ensure that activities were being performed in accordance with NRC requirements. Mr. Geoffrey Warren of my staff conducted an onsite exit meeting on December 4, 2015 to discuss the inspection findings.

During this inspection, the NRC staff examined activities conducted under your license related to public health and safety. Additionally, the staff examined your compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations as well as the conditions of your license. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selected examination of procedures and representative records, observations of activities, and interviews with personnel.

Based on the results of this inspection, the NRC has determined that Severity Level IV violations of NRC requirements occurred. The violations were evaluated in accordance with the NRC Enforcement Policy. The current Enforcement Policy is included on the NRC's website at <http://www.nrc.gov/about-nrc/regulatory/enforcement/enforce-pol.html>. The violations are of a security-related nature. Details of the violations are available in the enclosed, non-public security addendum (Enclosure 2). The violations are cited in the enclosed, non-public Notice of Violation (Notice) (Enclosure 1). The NRC is citing the violations in the enclosed Notice because the inspector identified them.

The NRC has concluded that information regarding the reason for the violations, the corrective actions taken and planned to correct the violations and prevent recurrence, and the date when full compliance was or will be achieved is already adequately addressed on the docket in the security addendum enclosed with this letter. Therefore, you are not required to respond to this
