Dear Shirley,

This letter is in reference to our application for renewal of our NRC License No. 21-24662-02E. I have attached the following:

- 1) Application for License renewal
- 2) Safety Evaluation of the Devices
- 3) Application of the Devices
- 4) Detailed prints of the Devices from MB-Microtech
- 5) Dimensional requirements for all sights (DWG #TTGSI-1986 REV. A)
- 6) Installation instructions for MB-Microtech inserts
- 7) Payment information

We are a machine shop that opened in 1982. We have been manufacturing sights with Trijicon since the mid 1980's. The designs of the sights that are still used to this day were developed using a combined effort from Tooltech and Trijicon. At the present time we mostly drill sights shipped to us from Trijicon for them to install tritium lamps. They inspect the sights prior to installing the inserts. We have never had a rejection.

Trijicon mass produces sights for popular firearms and does not make custom sights. Tooltech makes the custom sights for the customer if Trijicon cannot supply them. We do this following the same procedure and specifications as outlined in the Application of the Devices and per the installation instructions for MB-Microtech inserts. To further explain, all custom iron sights are made to the same specifications as the Trijicon sights. This means that the tritium lamp is placed into a specific size hole with specific minimal wall thickness on the iron sights, per attached print TTGSI-1986 REV. A. The only occasional difference is how we install the entire sight, not the tritium lamp.


Sometimes we have to alter/add a dovetail for the sight to fit onto the firearm. This only affects the lower part of the sight, not where the lamp is installed.

Trijicon recommends Tooltech on their website and through their phone system. This directs their customers to us if they want night sights installed onto a weapon that Trijicon does not make a "sight kit" for. Customers are also referred to us by Beretta, Smith & Wesson, Ruger, Taurus, Walther Arms and several other firearm manufacturers. There have been no changes to our process for the installation of these devices in all our years of business and it is the same process precisely as Trijicon's.

Since September 2014, Trijicon has been installing inserts into our sights while we've been working on getting our license renewed. Again, Trijicon inspects our custom sights and will not install an insert into any non-conforming part. They are licensed for the same process & using all of the same documents that we have attached. These documents still accurately represent our current exempt distribution license program and products.
