Dear Sir or Madam:

In accordance with 10 CFR section 30.34(b) and 10 CFR section 35.14(b), Connecticut Multispecialty Group, P.C. ("CMG") and Grove Hill Medical Center, P.C. ("GH") submit this request for consent to (1) consolidate GH's Material License No. 06-28798-01 into CMG's Material License No. 06-14854-01 and (2) to change the name of the Licensee on CMG's Material License No. 06-14854-01 to "Starling Physicians, P.C." This request is being made in connection with the proposed merger of GH with and into CMG to be effective on January 1, 2016, as described in paragraph 1 below (the "Merger"). The following information is provided about the Merger, in accordance with Volume 9, Appendix G and Volume 15 of the Consolidated Guidance about Material Licenses:

1. GH will merge with and into CMG through a statutory merger in accordance with Section 33-815 of the Connecticut Business Corporation Act (the "Act") to be effective on January 1, 2016 (the "Effective Date"). CMG will be the surviving corporation of the Merger and GH will be the merging corporation. As provided by the Act, all of the property, rights and contract rights, and liabilities of CMG and GH shall vest as a matter of law in the surviving corporation. On the Effective Date, all of the shareholders of CMG, which includes 79 physicians, and GH, which includes 60 physicians, shall be equal shareholders of the surviving corporation. The surviving entity shall be managed by the Executive Board of Directors with five directors elected by the former CMG shareholders and five directors elected by the former GH shareholders.
2. The name of the surviving corporation will be amended on the Effective Date to "Starling Physicians, P.C." which shall be the Licensee.

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4. The Chief Executive Officer of Starling Physicians, P.C. will be Michael G. Genovesi, M.D.
5. As of the Effective Date, there is no change in the Authorized Users. The Authorized Users under the Materials License shall be those Authorized Users included in CMG's Material License No. 06-14854-01 and GH's Material License No. 06-28798-01 for the medical uses listed below:

9. There shall be no changes in Starling Physicians' procedures, including routine operating and emergency procedures, the parties will need to submit the relevant procedural changes. The procedures currently in place at each location shall remain in effect.
  10. All required surveillance has been performed, documented, and reviewed, including the results thereof, if appropriate. The surveillance program of the licensee is current as of the Merger.
  11. Starling Physicians, P.C. will maintain all records of CMG and GH relating to decommissioning, if any. None of the facilities or equipment licensed for use by CMG and GH are being decommissioned. If decontamination or decommissioning is required after the Effective Date, it will be the financial responsibility of Starling Physicians, P.C. as the surviving corporation.
  12. Starling Physicians, P.C. shall abide by all constraints, license conditions, requirements, representations, and commitments identified in and attributed to the existing licenses (CMG's Material License No. 06-14854-01 and GH's Material License No. 06-28798-01). There are currently no open inspection items or enforcement actions against CMG or GH.
- CMG and GH request that the NRC review this request for licensure changes made in connection with the Merger, and provide its consent to the Merger transaction. 
