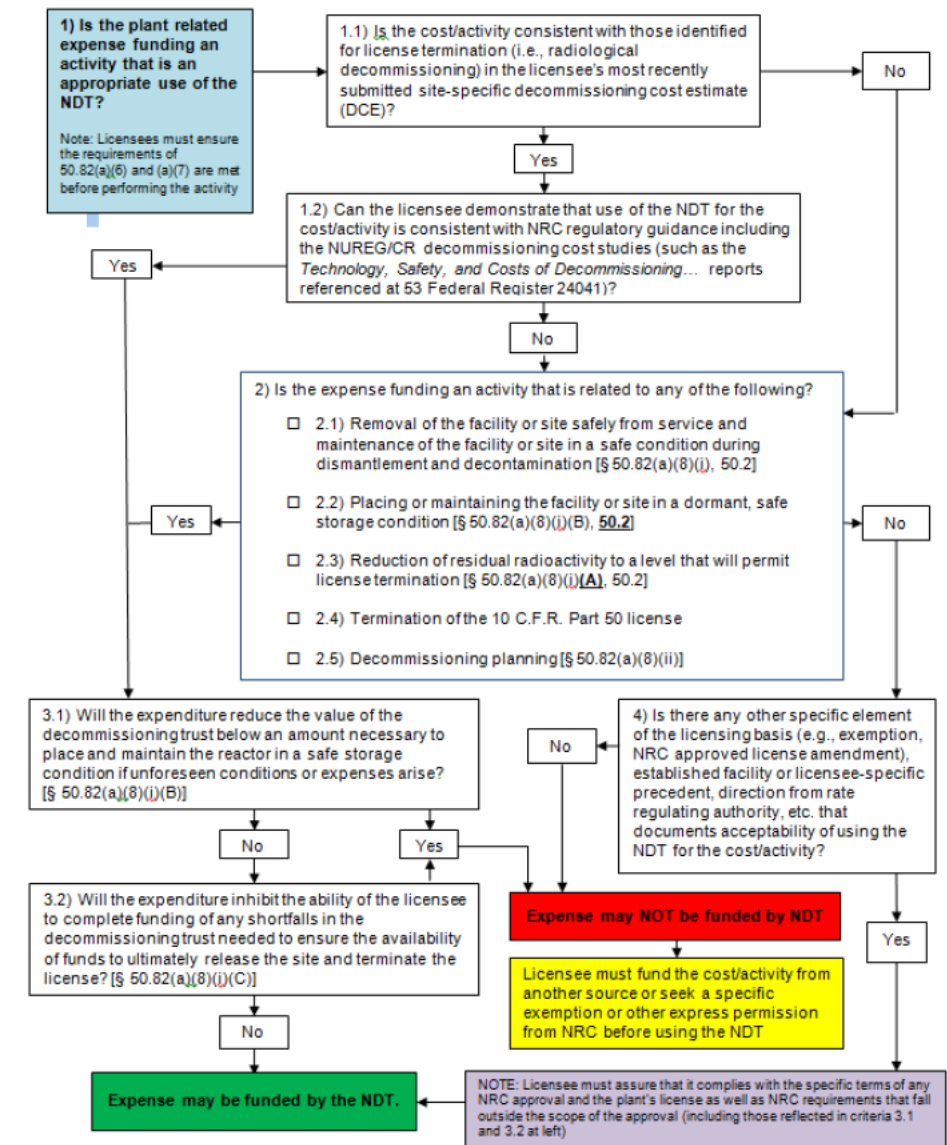
## NEI 15-06

- Goal: Assist licensees in identifying costs which are appropriately reimbursed from a nuclear decommissioning trust (NDT) consistent with the definition of decommissioning in 10 CFR 50.2
  - Addresses uncertainties of concern to licensees, NRC, and other stakeholders
  - Developed by NEI task force having considerable regulatory expertise and knowledge of industry experience
  - Serves as a source of information for all stakeholders.
  - NRC endorsement will provide regulatory predictability and stability

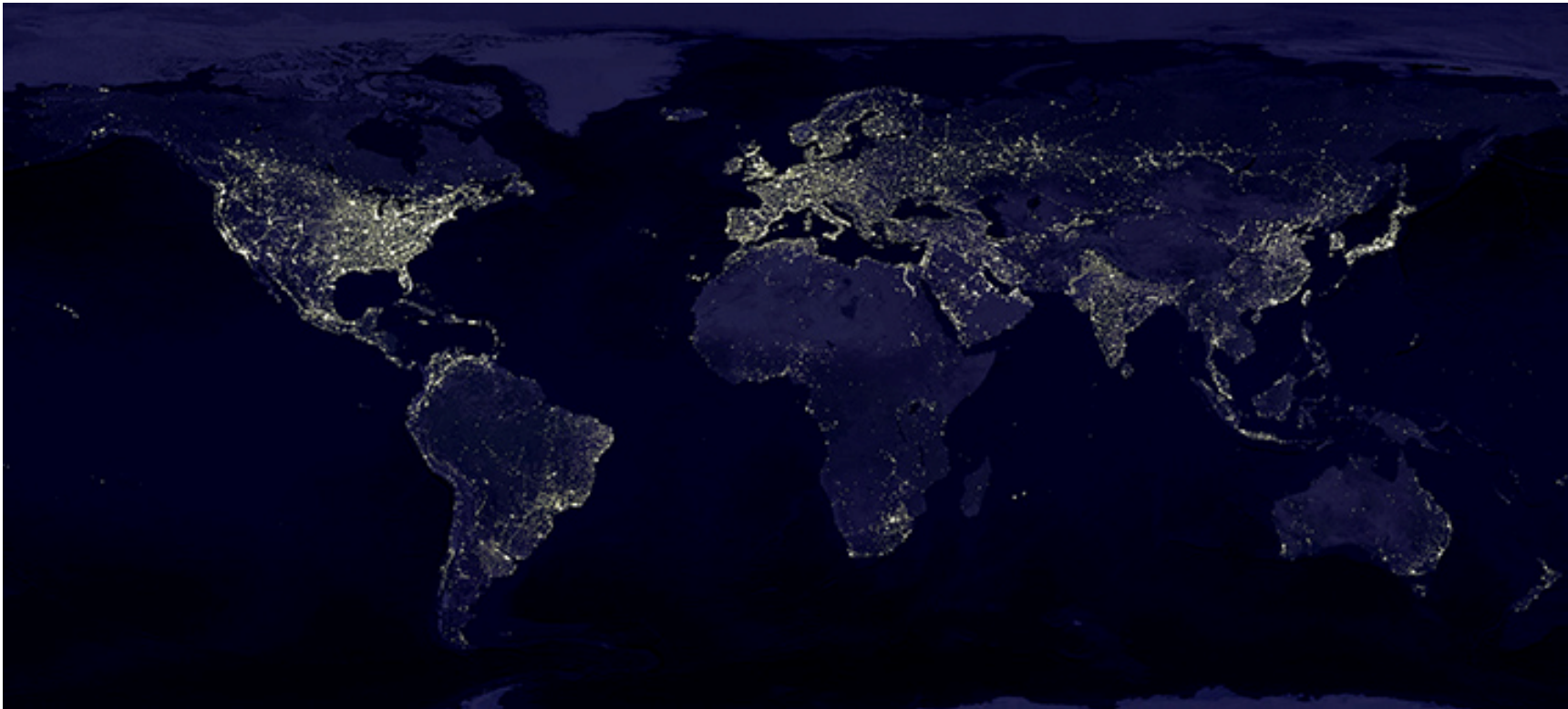
# Summary of NEI 15-06

- Identifies existing NRC guidance applicable to uses of NDT funds and preparation of decommissioning cost estimates
- Incorporates NRC feedback (as discussed in August 25, 2015 public meeting).
- Provides decision-making criteria in the form of a logic tree built on regulations and existing guidance.
- Supports licensees decision-making regarding the use of the Nuclear Decommissioning Trust Fund to safely and efficiently decommission permanently shut down plants
- Identifies non-NRC considerations that may be relevant to a licensee's decision to withdraw NDT funds
