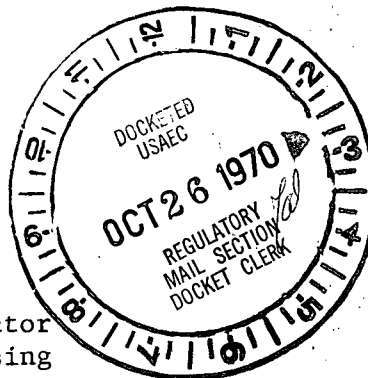

Dear Dr. Morris: Regulatory File Cv.

Duke Power Company is filing herewith Amendment No. 22 to its Application for Licenses for the Oconee Nuclear Station, which is under construction pursuant to provisional construction permits CPPR-33, -34, and -35 issued by the Commission on November 6, 1967. This filing includes three (3) signed original copies of the Amendment and nineteen (19) additional conformed copies.

This Amendment is submitted in reply to Dr. Peter A. Morris' letter of October 1, 1970, requesting additional financial data in accordance with Section 50-33(f) of 10CFR Part 50 which applies only to the operation of Oconee Nuclear Station Unit No. 1. The requested information is as follows:

1. The estimated annual costs of operating Oconee Unit No. 1 for a five-year period are:

(a) Operation and Maintenance	\$ 1,500,000
(b) Fuel Cost (No Carrying Charges)	7,042,800
(c) Advalorem Taxes	746,642
(d) Insurance	<u>736,000</u>

Total \$10,025,442

2. The estimated cost of permanently shutting down Oconee Unit No. 1 and maintaining it in a safe condition, if and when it may become necessary, is \$500,000. This estimate is based on the reactor (with fuel removed) and its associated nuclear systems remaining essentially in place and being isolated by fencing which would be monitored periodically by guards. The secondary side of the station would be salvaged.

The funds for these estimated costs will be obtained from the electrical operating revenues derived from system-wide operation of Duke Power Company.

This Amendment also incorporates by reference as part of the application Duke Power Company's Annual Financial Report for the year ending December 31, 1969, which was submitted with Duke's transmittal letter of September 24, 1970. This report is made a part of the application in accordance with Section 50-71(b) of 10CFR Part 50 and with Paragraph III of Appendix C to Part 50 of the Commission regulations.
