MEMORANDUM AND ORDER  
(Scheduling Prehearing Conference)

In response to the Licensing Board's January 6, 2016 memorandum and order concerning the schedule for a telephone prehearing conference with the parties, see Licensing Board Memorandum and Order (Requesting Scheduling Information for Prehearing Conference) (Jan. 6, 2016) at 2 (unpublished), a spokesperson for the parties contacted the Board on January 11 regarding their availability for the conference. Based on the information provided, the conference is being scheduled for Tuesday, January 26, 2016, beginning at 1:00 p.m. Eastern Time.<sup>1</sup>

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<sup>1</sup> The January 11 e-mail from the parties regarding the January 26 prehearing conference date indicated that counsel for intervenor Oglala Sioux Tribe (OST) would like the opportunity to meet in person with OST members in South Dakota before the conference call so he can be fully informed before the call, but that the conference date and winter weather may make that difficult. Given that the focus of the discussion in this conference will be on procedural matters, it is the Board's very strong preference that this conference go forward as scheduled on January 26. As was the case with the prior prehearing conference in this proceeding, see Licensing Board Memorandum and Order (Initial Prehearing Conference and Scheduling Order) (June 14, 2013) at 10 (unpublished), if there are matters that dictate further post-conference discussion among the parties or between counsel and his/her client, during the

The Licensing Board will establish a bridge line for this conference, with two lines provided for each party.<sup>2</sup> In the near future, Board personnel will contact the parties with instructions on how to access the telephone bridge. In addition, the Board will provide a “listen only” capability for members of the public, with access information available in the near future via an NRC website notice regarding the prehearing conference.

During the conference, the Board would like to discuss with the parties (1) NRC staff plans for the public availability of the balance of its draft environmental assessment/finding of no significant impact (EA/FONSI);<sup>3</sup> (2) potential filing of new/amended contentions; (3) submission of summary disposition motions; (4) seriatim rather than simultaneous submission of prefiled

testimony and position statements; (5) submission of in limine motions; and (6) party/witness availability for a one-to-three-day hearing during the April-September 2017 time frame.
