SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF DECEMBER 3, 2015, PARTIALLY CLOSED MEETING

WITH NAC INTERNATIONAL TO DISCUSS ISSUES ASSOCIATED

WITH THE MODEL NO. NAC-STC PACKAGE AMENDMENT

REQUEST NO. 14

Background

A partially-closed meeting was held on December 3, 2015, in Rockville, Maryland, at the request of the NAC International (NAC, the applicant) to discuss unresolved issues associated with the portion of the amendment request to add uncanistered directly-loaded high-burnup fuel as authorized contents to the Model No. NAC-STC transport package. NAC also seeks to include high-level vitrified waste from the West Valley Demonstration Project as authorized contents under the same amendment request, but the meeting did not include discussion on this subject.

The meeting notice was added in ADAMS¹ on November 18, 2015 (ADAMS Accession No. ML15321A466). The meeting was partially closed to the public, since, per NAC, the majority of the information shared was proprietary. NAC provided presentation slides on December 2 and December 4.²³ A public version of the summary of the technical discussion is included in Enclosure 1. The non-public version of the summary of the technical discussion is included in Enclosure 2. The meeting attendees' list and agenda can be found in Enclosures 3 and 4, respectively. The public version of NAC's presentation slides are located in ADAMS Accession No. ML15336A961.³ Enclosure 5 includes the presentation slides discussed at the meeting and submitted on December 4.

Upon removal of Enclosures 2 and 5, this document is uncontrolled.

Discussion

In November 2013, NAC submitted an application to revise the certificate of compliance for the NAC-STC transport package to include high-level vitrified waste from the West Valley Demonstration Project and uncanistered directly-loaded high burnup fuel as authorized contents for the NAC-STC.¹ The Table below includes a synopsis of the supplements submitted by the applicant.

The applicant also submitted supplemental information on September 11, 2015, and October 15, 2015. In general, the staff found that information provided by the applicant regarding the evaluation of uncanistered directly-loaded high burnup fuel was insufficient to support the proposed licensing approach. The staff informed the applicant about the unresolved issues associated with uncanistered directly-loaded high burnup fuel in a letter dated November 24, 2015 (ADAMS Package Accession No. ML15328A484).

The discussion generally followed the agenda (Enclosure 4). The primary reasons for the meeting were for NAC to:

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- 1. discuss the unresolved technical issues associated with the uncanistered directly-loaded high-burnup fuel portion identified by the staff; and
- 2. discuss potential approaches for addressing these technical issues and defining a path forward regarding this licensing action request.

To support these goals, the staff listened to a presentation from NAC explaining changes to its proposed methodology for evaluating uncanistered directly-loaded high burnup fuel as authorized contents of the NAC-STC transport package.

Several representatives from NAC attended and participated during the meeting. Staff from headquarters also attended the meeting. No regulatory decisions were made at this meeting. A summary of the technical discussion is included in Enclosure 1 of this document.
