Ladies and Gentlemen,

On March 6, 2015 Duke Energy submitted a supplement letter (Reference 3) to Duke Energy's response to the NRC's 10 CFR 50.54(f) letters dated August 15, 2008 (Reference 1) and March 12, 2012 (Reference 2) for the purpose of communicating Duke Energy's approach to address the regulatory matters associated with flooding caused by a postulated Jocassee Dam failure. This letter provides Duke Energy's updated position.

ANRR

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As in the March 6, 2015 letter, the approach is discussed in more detail in the enclosure to this letter and refers to Duke Energy's submittal of a revised Flood Hazard Reevaluation Report (FHRR) for Oconee Nuclear Station (Reference 4). This updated FHRR was subsequently accepted by the NRC in the September 24, 2015, "Interim Staff Response to Reevaluated Flood Hazards Submitted in Response to 10 CFR 50.54(f) Information Request – Flood-causing Mechanism Reevaluation" (Reference 5).
