Carolyn,

Just wanted to let you know that I noticed a discrepancy between NWMI PSAR Table 4-75 and the NWMI response to RAI AIR-2B (ADAMS No. ML15328A010). Table 4-75 of the PSAR identifies the chemicals and quantity as proprietary, however, NWMI's response to RAI AIR-2B did not mark this information as proprietary. Because it is not clear if this information is or isn't proprietary, draft RAI AIR2-2a will be revised to not reference the chemical or quantity. The staff did not identify additional sensitive or proprietary information in the draft RAIs during its review. Since I have not received a response from NWMI regarding proprietary information in the draft RAIs, I will assume NWMI did not identify proprietary information in the RAIs and you will receive a formal letter and the RAIs.
