SUBJECT: RESPONSE TO NRC INSPECTION REPORT 030-38669/2015-001 AND
NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Dear Mr. Phillips:

On December 8, 2015, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) cited High-Tech Testing Service, Inc. for the failure to comply with the training requirements found in Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulation* (10 CFR) Part 37. The Notice of Violation (Notice), enclosed with Inspection Report 030- 38669/2015-001 (ML15342A452), required you to respond in writing within 30 days. You responded by electronic mail received on January 5, 2016 (ML16006A576).

After reviewing the information you provided in your response to the Notice, we have concluded that your completed and proposed corrective actions appear to adequately address the regulatory noncompliance described in the Notice. We will review your implementation of these corrective actions during a future inspection to determine whether full compliance has been restored and whether compliance will be maintained.
