Dear Mr. Comley:

I am responding to the letter and materials we received from you on July 16, 2014, in which you raised a number of concerns regarding emergency preparedness around Seabrook Station, alleged counterfeit/substandard parts in use in the nuclear industry, alleged NRC wrongdoing, and several other related matters. In response to your concerns, we reviewed your letter and its multiple enclosures against the materials you previously provided in December 2013, as well as your remarks at the December 18, 2013, public meeting in Hampton, NH, and your various emails to Richard Barkley of my staff. Our review did not identify any relevant new technical issues that were not addressed in my prior letter to you dated February 12, 2014. Thus no further action was taken in this matter by NRC Region I.

In response to your assertions regarding NRC wrongdoing, we noted that a number of your concerns are quite historical in nature, stemming back to your interactions with senior agency officials many years ago. Nevertheless, we provided your materials to the NRC Office of Inspector General for their review.
