The purpose of this submittal is to correct the Enclosure 1 page numbering in the submittal referenced above and resubmit AREVA TN Americas Updated Licensing Plans. Please disregard the submittal referenced above in its entirety.

Consistent with the guidance in RIS 2005-27, AREVA TN Americas (formerly Transnuclear, Inc.) herein submits to NRC updated licensing plans. Currently AREVA TN Americas has the following licensing actions under NRC review:

- An application for renewal of Certificate of Compliance (CoC) 1004 for the Standardized NUHOMS[®] System was submitted to NRC for review and approval on November 4, 2014.
- An application for a new CoC, CoC 1042 for the NUHOMS[®] EOS System was submitted to NRC for review and approval on June 16, 2015.
- An application for Renewal and Revision to CoC 9233 for the TN-RAM transportation packaging was submitted to NRC for review and approval on March 9, 2015.
- An application for Amendment 14 to Standardized NUHOMS[®] System CoC 1004 was submitted to NRC for review and approval on April 16, 2015.
- An application to revise all amendments of Certificate of Compliance (CoC) 1004 for the Standardized NUHOMS[®] System was submitted to NRC for review and approval on August 24, 2015.

The future licensing plans contained in Enclosure 1 are proprietary in nature and in accordance with 10 CFR 2.390(b), an affidavit is provided specifically requesting that you withhold this information from public disclosure.

I have personal knowledge of the criteria and procedures utilized by AREVA Inc. in designating information as a trade secret, privileged, or as confidential commercial or financial information.

Pursuant to the provisions of paragraph (b) (4) of Section 2.390 of the Commission’s regulations, the following is furnished for consideration by the Commission in determining whether the information sought to be withheld from public disclosure, included in the above referenced document, should be withheld.


- 1) The information sought to be withheld from public disclosure is a list of identified future licensing action plans, which involve considerable research and development of intellectual property by AREVA Inc.
- 2) The information is of a type customarily held in confidence by AREVA Inc. and not customarily disclosed to the public. AREVA Inc. has a rational basis for determining the types of information customarily held in confidence by it.
- 3) Public disclosure of the information is likely to cause substantial harm to the competitive position of AREVA Inc. because the information consists of near term and long term licensing plan which involves research and development activities for dry spent fuel storage and transportation systems, the application of which provide a competitive economic advantage. The availability of such information to competitors would enable them to modify their plans and products to better compete with AREVA Inc., to take marketing or other actions to improve their product’s position, or to impair the position of AREVA Inc.’s products and avoid developing similar data and analyses in support of their processes, methods, or apparatus.
