Abstract				
This rule would assure that Nuclear Regulatory Commission licensed fuel cycle facilities provide reasonable assurance that digital assets associated with safety, security, emergency preparedness, and material control and accountability are adequately protected from cyber-attacks.				
Justification				
This rule scores 35 points (14, 10, 8, 3) because of the following reasons: A) Moderate contributor toward one or more goals and implements multiple strategies in one or more goals (security strategies 1, 3, and 5); B) Significant contributor toward one or more strategies (regulatory effectiveness strategies 1 and 2); C) Significant contributor toward one or more considerations or the Commission has provided specific direction and priority/schedule on the rulemaking. Significant contributor to future regulatory benefit; and D) Significant interest of the U.S. Department of Homeland Security.
