I called and left you voice mail this morning concerning the subject license amendment application review and I am following up with this email.

The Army submitted its amendment application to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission for possession of depleted uranium at various sites at 17 different Army installations across the United States. One of the sites is located at Fort Bragg NC. In October 2015, the NRC sent consultation letters to the applicable SHPOs. It was just brought to my attention that I inadvertently overlooked contacting the North Carolina SHPO.
