Dear Mr. McGondel,

I've reviewed your exempt distribution report dated January 14, 2016 (ML16020A393).

Please revise and resubmit your report to indicate that the products are transferred for use under 10 CFR 30.15, giving the specific paragraph designation [i.e., 10 CFR 30.15(a)(8)].

Also, the regulations concerning annual reporting for your license state that the information in your report should reference model numbers, if applicable, and your report did not include reference to model numbers. Please revise your report according to model numbers or, as we discussed over the telephone on January 26, 2016, explain why model numbers would not be applicable.

The report must include the following information on products transferred to other persons for use under § 30.15 or equivalent regulations of an Agreement State:

(3) The number of units of each type of product transferred during the reporting period by model number, if applicable.
