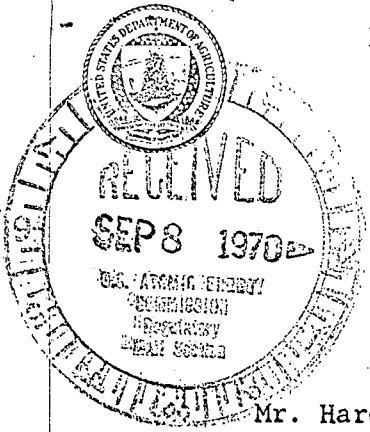

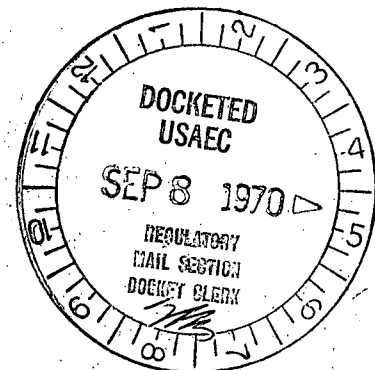
Dear Mr. Price:
