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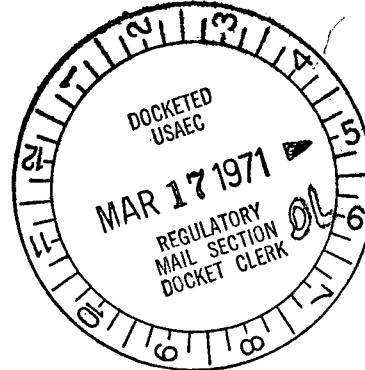

This will confirm an understanding reached today with Joseph Knotts of the General Counsel's Office regarding Duke Power Company's response to the questions submitted by you on February 25, 1971 with respect to its Ocone and McGuire nuclear power applications.

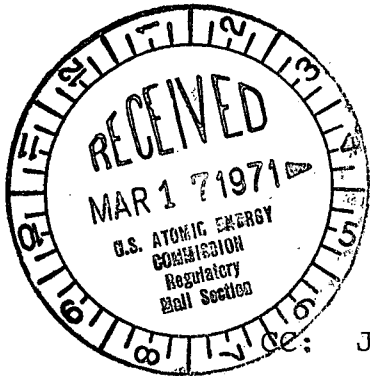
Duke Power Company has had difficulty in assembling the information called for, and will be unable to do so by the due date, March 22, 1971. It is understood that Duke Power will supply not later than March 29, 1971, all materials which it has available by that date. Any materials, including statistics requiring retabulation or compilation, which are not available by that date, will be supplied not later than April 5, 1971.

If Duke Power has any questions with regard to the meaning or coverage of questions, or objects to any question, it will advise the Commission not later than March 22, 1971.
