Enclosure 2 of Reference 1 contains specific Requested Actions, Requested Information, and Required Responses associated with Near-Term Task Force Recommendation 2.1, Flooding. The enclosure of Reference 2 provides WCNO's Flood Hazard Reevaluation Report (FHRR), Revision 0.



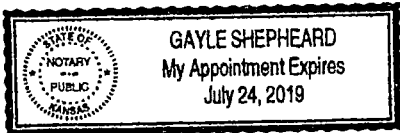
