I've reviewed your exempt distribution report dated January 14, 2016.

Your report indicated that your products are transferred for use under 10 CFR 30.18. Please note that your license only authorizes the transfer of products for use under 10 CFR 30.20. Also, your report did not include, for each radionuclide in each type of product and each model number, the total quantity of the radionuclide transferred, as required by 10 CFR 32.29(c)(3)(ii). Please revise and resubmit your report to remove reference to the use of your products under 10 CFR 30.18, and to include the total quantity of each radionuclide transferred. Further information about the requirements that apply to annual reports of exempt distribution can be found in the attached Regulatory Issue Summary.
