Dear COL Cornes:

This refers to your license amendment request. Enclosed with this letter is the amended license removing the requested authorized users and adding the new Health Physics Lab. This Amendment adds the new facility as requested to enable you to move your lab. Prior to release of your current lab for unrestricted use, you must receive an Amendment removing your current lab from your license. Include in the request, the results of surveys demonstrating that the levels of residual activity in the room are acceptable. When you submit the Amendment request, please refer to the Control Number at the top of this letter.

Please note that your license has been limited to Iodine-131 use only under 10 CFR 35.300 (see Items 6.C. and 9.C.). This change was made to reflect that the authorized users previously approved for full 10 CFR 35.300 uses were removed from the license during this amendment and the remaining authorized users have authorizations limited to Iodine-131 use only.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand and fully implement all the conditions incorporated into the amended license. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region I Office, Licensing Assistance Team, (610) 337-5239, so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

An environmental assessment for this action is not required, since this action is categorically excluded under 10 CFR 51.22(c)(14).
