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## General Comment

1. The decommissioning funds must be spent exclusively on the radiological cleanup, and specifically not on operational expenses.
2. The Emergency Planning Zones and the requirements for off-site insurance must be undiminished until the spent fuel pool is empty, since the dangers posed by the spent fuel in the pool can far outweigh the dangers posed by the reactor itself.
3. The utility must be prevented from breaking up in such a way that the parent company has reduced financial liability for the cleanup.
