As a follow-up to our phone conversation this morning, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) is about to issue license amendments for the St. Lucie Nuclear Plant, Units 1 and 2. In accordance with Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Section 50.91(b), I am notifying you of the proposed issuance of these amendments.

Please reply if the State of Florida has comments on the following licensing action submitted to the NRC by Florida Power & Light Company, et al. (the licensee): "Application for Technical Specifications Changes to Remove Communications and Manipulator Crane Requirements and Relocate to Licensee-Controlled Documents" dated March 10, 2015 (Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) Accession No. ML15084A141), as supplemented by a letter dated December 15, 2015 (ADAMS ML16005A146).

The associated proposed no significant hazards consideration for this amendment request was published in the Federal Register on October 13, 2015, (80 FR 61476).
