SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF JANUARY 7, 2016, MEETING WITH EXELON GENERATION COMPANY, LLC ON ITS PLANNED FLEET LICENSE AMENDMENT REQUEST TO REVISE THE MINIMUM STAFFING REQUIREMENTS FOR EMERGENCY RESPONSE (CAC NOS. MF7162-MF7183)

On January 7, 2016, a Category 1 public meeting was held between the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) and representatives of Exelon Generation Company, LLC (Exelon, the licensee) via teleconference. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss Exelon's planned fleet license amendment request (LAR) to revise the minimum staffing requirements for emergency response. The meeting notice and agenda, dated December 18, 2015, are available in the Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) at Accession No. ML15352A075. A list of attendees is enclosed.

Exelon's planned LAR would revise its standardized radiological emergency plan and site specific annexes for its entire fleet of nuclear reactors, with the possible exception of Oyster Creek Nuclear Generating Station (Oyster Creek). The proposed changes would realign the emergency response organization staffing at all of the sites to a more consistent level of staffing based on the guidance in Table B-1, "Minimum Staffing Requirements for NRC Licensees for Nuclear Power Plant Emergencies," of NUREG-0654/FEMA-REP-1, Revision 1, "Criteria for Preparation and Evaluation of Radiological Emergency Response Plans and Preparedness in Support of Nuclear Power Plants" (ADAMS Accession No. ML040420012). Exelon stated that it plans to submit the LAR in June 2016.

Exelon's emergency response organization consists of an on-shift complement as well as an augmented complement within a specified timeframe. Exelon described the proposed changes, the content of the LAR, the evaluation process used to justify the changes, and the timing of the proposed changes. The NRC staff provided a discussion on the evaluation process used to perform these types of changes in the past, historical issues with other changes, and offered additional opportunity for discussion prior to the submittal.

Oyster Creek is scheduled to be permanently shutdown in 2019 and enter a decommissioning status. Exelon stated that it plans to submit a separate LAR for Oyster Creek this year to establish its emergency plan for decommissioning. Exelon asked if including Oyster Creek in the planned fleet LAR to reduce minimum staffing levels would cause a concern during the acceptance review for the two LARs. The NRC technical staff did express some concern about how the safety evaluation would be written. However, the NRC project manager noted that including Oyster Creek in the fleet LAR would not likely cause a problem during the acceptance review and encouraged Exelon to have further dialog with the NRC project manager for Oyster Creek.
