SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF THE PUBLIC MEETING TO DISCUSS THE U.S.  
NUCLEAR REGULATORY COMMISSION DRAFT SUBSEQUENT  
LICENSE RENEWAL GUIDANCE DOCUMENTS

On January 21, 2016, the Division of License Renewal in the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC's) Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation (NRR) hosted a public meeting with representatives of the Nuclear Energy Institute, individual licensees, and interested stakeholders. The purpose of the meeting was for the staff to present the significant changes to the NRC draft guidance documents for subsequent license renewal (SLR) related to the mechanical aging management programs (AMPs), answer questions, and to receive preliminary feedback in preparation for public comments.

In December 2015, the NRC published for comment their draft guidance documents for SLR, NUREG 2192, "Standard Review Plan for Review of Subsequent License Renewal Applications for Nuclear Power Plants," and NUREG-2191, the "Generic Aging Lessons Learned for Subsequent License Renewal Report." The documents were noticed for public comment on December 23, 2015, in the Federal Register (80 FR 79956, <https://federalregister.gov/a/2015-32368>). The staff is seeking public comments on the changes in the guidance documents so that the final guidance documents will provide a stable and acceptable evaluation standard for SLR applications. The public comment period will close February 29, 2016.

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The agenda and slide presentations are available in the NRC's Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS), under Accession No. ML15168A958, ML16034A607, and ML16034A608. A summary of the meeting discussion follows:

At the meeting, the staff presented the significant changes to the mechanical AMPs from the AMPs in the current guidance documents for first license renewal. Representatives from the nuclear power plant industry provided preliminary feedback on the mechanical AMPs and sections of the draft guidance documents related to mechanical components. Participants and staff at the meeting indicated that the meeting was beneficial to provide utilities, who are considering submitting an application for SLR, a better understanding of the proposed changes and their impact on operations in the subsequent period of extended operation. A second meeting is planned for February 19, 2016, to discuss sections of the guidance documents dealing with structural and electrical equipment and their recommended AMPs. An additional public meeting will be held later in March or April 2016 to continue the discussion.
